(a) (5) The provisions of paragraph (1) of this subsection relating to distance from a church or place of worship do not apply to EITHER the issuance of a 1-day alcoholic beverages license for use within a building OR TO THE ISSUANCE OF A CLASS H BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE ISSUED UNDER § 24B(D) OF THIS ARTICLE TO A CATERER FOR USE IN A BANQUET FACILITY LOCATED WITHIN A BUILDING if:

(i) The construction of the building is completed after July 1, 1991;

and

(ii) The building is used for emergency operations by a volunteer fire company.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the publishers of the Annotated Code of Maryland, after consultation with the Director of the Department of Legislative Reference, shall correct any cross-references rendered incorrect by the passage of this Act.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 428

(House Bill 1552)

AN ACT concerning

**Baltimore County – Alcoholic Beverages
(Towson Town Center)**
