(c) The restrictions and qualifications for issuance, fee, minimum square foot area requirement for food and beverage preparation and consumption, and days and hours of sale under a Class B (TTC) restaurant beer, wine and liquor (on-sale) license are the same as provided in this article and the rules and regulations of the Baltimore County Board of License Commissioners for a Class B beer, wine and liquor (on-sale) hotel and restaurant license in Baltimore County, with the following additional requirements:

(11) Alcoholic beverages may be sold in the establishment only until [12:30] 1:30 a.m.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act are subject to the abrogation provisions of Chapter 452 of the Acts of 1991.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.
