- (b) (1) The Governor shall appoint the registered nurse members, with the advice of the Secretary, from a list of qualified individuals submitted to the Secretary and the Governor by the Maryland Nurses Association, Inc. The number of names on the list shall be [five] 5 times the number of vacancies.
- (2) The Governor shall appoint the licensed practical nurse members, with the advice of the Secretary, from a list of qualified individuals submitted to the Secretary and the Governor by the Maryland Licensed Practical Nurse Association, Inc. The number of names on the list shall be [five] 5 times the number of vacancies.
- (3) THE LISTS SUBMITTED BY THE MARYLAND NURSES ASSOCIATION, INC. AND THE MARYLAND LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE ASSOCIATION, INC. SHALL EACH CONTAIN THAT NUMBER OF NAMES WHICH IS 5 TIMES THE NUMBER OF VACANCIES.
- $\{(3)\}$ (4) The Governor may request an additional list of [five] 5 nominees for each vacancy.
- $\{(4)\}$ (5) The Governor shall make the appointment for each vacancy from the original list or the additional list.
- $\{(5)\}$ (6) The Governor shall appoint the consumer members with the advice of the Secretary and the advice and consent of the Senate.
- (i) (1) The term of a member is 3 years, except that the initial term of [one] 1 of the consumer members is 2 years.
- (2) The terms of the members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Board on July 1, 1981.
- (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (5) A member may not be appointed for more than [three] 3 consecutive 3-year terms.
- (6) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL FILL ANY VACANCY ON THE BOARD WITHIN 60 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE VACANCY.
