

(2) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL FILL ANY VACANCY ON THE BOARD WITHIN 60 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE VACANCY.

(g) (1) On the recommendation of the Board, the Secretary may remove any member of the Board for neglect of duty, misconduct, malfeasance, or misfeasance in office.

(2) UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE SECRETARY, THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER WHOM THE SECRETARY FINDS TO HAVE BEEN ABSENT FROM 2 SUCCESSIVE BOARD MEETINGS WITHOUT ADEQUATE REASON.

[(2)](3) The Governor may remove a member for incompetence or misconduct.

(a) The Governor shall appoint the chairman of the Board from among the physician members on the Board.

(b) From among its members, the Board shall elect a secretary-treasurer and any other officers that it considers necessary.

[(c) The manner of election of officers and their terms of office shall be as the Board determines.]

(C) THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE:

- (1) THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS;
- (2) THE TERM OF OFFICE OF EACH OFFICER; AND
- (3) THE DUTIES OF EACH OFFICER.

(A) The Board shall adopt regulations governing:

- (1) The term of office for Committee members;
 - (2) The procedure for filling vacancies on the Committee;
 - (3) The appointment of a chairperson and other officers for the Committee;

- (4) The removal of Committee members; AND
 - (5) THE DUTIES OF EACH OFFICER.
