- (2) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL FILL ANY VACANCY ON THE BOARD WITHIN 60 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE VACANCY.
- (g) (1) On the recommendation of the Board, the Secretary may remove any member of the Board for neglect of duty, misconduct, malfeasance, or misfeasance in office.
- (2) UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE SECRETARY, THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER WHOM THE SECRETARY FINDS TO HAVE BEEN ABSENT FROM 2 SUCCESSIVE BOARD MEETINGS WITHOUT ADEQUATE REASON.
- [(2)](3) The Governor may remove a member for incompetence or misconduct.

- (a) The Governor shall appoint the chairman of the Board from among the physician members on the Board.
- (b) From among its members, the Board shall elect a secretary-treasurer and any other officers that it considers necessary.
- [(c) The manner of election of officers and their terms of office shall be as the Board determines.]
