

- (1) Act on each examination promptly; and
- (2) Record the results of each examination in the Board's minutes.

- (e) (1) The term of a member is 3 years.
- (2) The terms of the members of the Board are staggered as required by the terms of the members of the Board serving on July 1, 1988.
- (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) A member of the Board may not serve more than 2 3-year terms.
- (5) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL FILL ANY VACANCY ON THE BOARD WITHIN 60 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE VACANCY.

(f) (1) The Governor may remove a member for incompetency, misconduct, or neglect of duty.

(2) UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE SECRETARY, THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER WHOM THE SECRETARY FINDS TO HAVE BEEN ABSENT FROM 2 SUCCESSIVE BOARD MEETINGS WITHOUT ADEQUATE REASON.

- (a) From among its members, the Board annually shall elect:
- (1) A chairperson;
 - (2) A vice chairperson; and
 - (3) A secretary.

[(b) The manner of election of officers, their duties, and their terms of office shall be as the Board determines.]

(B) THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE:

- (1) THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS;
- (2) THE TERM OF OFFICE OF EACH OFFICER; AND
- (3) THE DUTIES OF EACH OFFICER.
