- (iii) [11] 13 15 members appointed by the Governor AS FOLLOWS:
- 1. ONE MEMBER TWO MEMBERS RECOMMENDED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES;
- 2. ONE MEMBER RECOMMENDED BY THE MARYLAND MUNICIPAL LEAGUE;
- 3. AT LEAST ONE MEMBER FROM WESTERN MARYLAND (GARRETT, ALLEGANY, AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES);
- 4. AT LEAST ONE MEMBER FROM CENTRAL MARYLAND (FREDERICK, CARROLL, AND HOWARD COUNTIES);
- 5. AT LEAST ONE MEMBER FROM SOUTHERN MARYLAND (CHARLES, ST. MARY'S, AND CALVERT COUNTIES);
- 6. AT LEAST ONE MEMBER FROM THE UPPER EASTERN SHORE (CECIL, KENT, QUEEN ANNE'S, TALBOT, AND CAROLINE COUNTIES);
- 7. AT LEAST ONE MEMBER FROM THE LOWER EASTERN SHORE (DORCHESTER, WICOMICO, SOMERSET, AND WORCESTER COUNTIES);
- 8. AT LEAST ONE MEMBER FROM <u>EACH COUNTY IN</u> THE METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON AREA (PRINCE GEORGE'S AND MONTGOMERY COUNTIES); AND
- 9. AT LEAST ONE MEMBER FROM <u>EACH OF THE FOLLOWING PORTIONS OF THE BALTIMORE METROPOLITAN AREA</u>6:
 - A. ANNE ARUNDEL, COUNTY;
 - B. BALTIMORE; AND HARFORD COUNTIES; AND
 - C. BALTIMORE CITY).
- (2) A member appointed by the Governor may not hold a salaried State office.
- (3) As far as possible, members appointed by the Governor shall be selected to reflect different broad geographic, economic, and social interests in the State, AND TO REPRESENT BUSINESS, FINANCE, AGRICULTURAL, <u>FORESTRY</u>, ENVIRONMENTAL, CIVIC, <u>PLANNING</u>, AND REAL ESTATE DEVELOPMENT INTERESTS.
- (b) (1) A member appointed by the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the House serves at the pleasure of the appointing authority.
- (2) (i) The term of a member appointed by the Governor is 4 years and begins on June 1 in the year in which the member is appointed.
