

(ii) At the end of a term, a member appointed by the Governor continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(iii) A member who is appointed by the Governor after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(IV) THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ON OCTOBER 1, 1992.

(V) A MEMBER MAY SERVE NO MORE THAN 2 TERMS.

(VI) IF A VACANCY ARISES OTHER THAN BY THE EXPIRATION OF A TERM, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT WITHIN 30 DAYS A SUCCESSOR OF LIKE QUALIFICATION TO SERVE THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM.

5-704.

From among the Commission members, the Governor shall appoint a chairman of the Commission.

5-705.

(a) The Director shall PROVIDE STAFF SUPPORT TO THE COMMISSION AND designate a member of the staff of the Office to serve as the Secretary to the Commission.

(b) The duties of the Secretary to the Commission are in addition to that individual's regular duties of employment with the Office.

5-706.

(a) (1) The Commission shall meet:

(i) [at least twice] AS OFTEN AS NEEDED AND NOT LESS THAN 4 TIMES a year, at the times and places it determines; and

(ii) at the call of the Director or the chairman.

(2) The chairman shall call a meeting of the Commission whenever requested to do so by:

(i) the Director; or

(ii) any [3] 5 members of the Commission.

(b) A member of the Commission:

(1) may not receive compensation; but

(2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
