- (ii) At the end of a term, a member appointed by the Governor continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (iii) A member who is appointed by the Governor after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (IV) THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ON OCTOBER 1, 1992.
 - (V) A MEMBER MAY SERVE NO MORE THAN 2 TERMS.
- (VI) IF A VACANCY ARISES OTHER THAN BY THE EXPIRATION OF A TERM, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT WITHIN 30 DAYS A SUCCESSOR OF LIKE QUALIFICATION TO SERVE THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM.

5-704.

From among the Commission members, the Governor shall appoint a chairman of the Commission.

5-705.

- (a) The Director shall PROVIDE STAFF SUPPORT TO THE COMMISSION AND designate a member of the staff of the Office to serve as the Secretary to the Commission.
- (b) The duties of the Secretary to the Commission are in addition to that individual's regular duties of employment with the Office.

 5-706.
 - (a) (1) The Commission shall meet:
- (i) [at least twice] AS OFTEN AS NEEDED AND NOT LESS THAN 4 TIMES a year, at the times and places it determines; and
 - (ii) at the call of the Director or the chairman.
- (2) The chairman shall call a meeting of the Commission whenever requested to do so by:
 - (i) the Director; or
 - (ii) any [3] 5 members of the Commission.
 - (b) A member of the Commission:
 - (1) may not receive compensation; but
- (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
