(a) [With the approval of the Director of Planning, the] THE Commission [may] SHALL establish THE FOLLOWING STANDING SUBCOMMITTEES AND MAY ESTABLISH OTHER subcommittees[.] AS NEEDED:

(1) THE SUBCOMMITTEE ON INTERJURISDICTIONAL COORDINATION, WHICH SHALL PROMOTE PLANNING COORDINATION AND INTERJURISDICTIONAL COOPERATION AMONG ALL JURISDICTIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE STATE'S ECONOMIC GROWTH, RESOURCE PROTECTION, AND PLANNING POLICY;

(2) THE SUBCOMMITTEE ON PLANNING, WHICH SHALL PROMOTE EDUCATION AND OUTREACH ACTIVITIES; ~~AND~~

(3) THE SUBCOMMITTEE ON PLANNING TECHNIQUES SHALL DEVELOP AND PROMOTE THE USE OF PLANNING GUIDELINES, MODELS, EXAMPLES, AND OTHER PLANNING TOOLS NEEDED TO IMPLEMENT THE STATE'S ECONOMIC GROWTH, RESOURCE PROTECTION, AND PLANNING POLICY AND LOCAL PLANS; AND

~~(3)~~ (4) THE SUBCOMMITTEE ON THE ENVIRONMENT AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, WHICH SHALL PROMOTE BALANCED ECONOMIC GROWTH, EFFECTIVE PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT, AND COOPERATION AMONG THE STATE'S ENVIRONMENTAL AND DEVELOPMENT INTERESTS.

(b) The Commission may delegate any function of the Commission to a subcommittee.

(c) The chairman may appoint to a subcommittee any individual specially qualified in matters to be considered by the subcommittee.

(d) [Unless authorized by a majority vote of the Commission and approved by the Director of Planning, the number of members of the subcommittee who are not members of the Commission shall be less than the number of members of the subcommittee who are members of the Commission.

(e)] Each member of a subcommittee is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

(E) THE TERM OF A MEMBER OF A STANDING SUBCOMMITTEE IS 4 YEARS.

(F) EACH SUBCOMMITTEE SHALL PREPARE AND SUBMIT FINDINGS TO THE COMMISSION BY JUNE 1, 1993 AND BY JUNE 1 OF EACH YEAR THEREAFTER.
