- (H) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION, ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2002, AN EVALUATION SHALL BE MADE OF THE STATE ECONOMIC GROWTH AND RESOURCE, RESOURCE PROTECTION, AND PLANNING COMMISSION ESTABLISHED UNDER THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That no provision of this Act shall apply to any capital project for which a valid building permit or a State commitment for a grant, loan, loan guarantee, or insurance for a capital project has been issued, or for which final review under the National Environmental Policy Act or the Maryland Environmental Policy Act is completed by October 1, 1992, or for which final review through the State Clearinghouse for Intergovernmental Assistance is completed by January 1, 1993.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, the standing subcommittees of the State Economic Growth and Resource, Resource Protection, and Planning Commission established under Section 1 of this Act shall be composed initially of the following members, who shall serve for initial terms of 2 years:
- (a) The Subcommittee on Interjurisdictional Coordination shall be composed of the following members, who should have experience and interest in regional and intergovernmental activities:
- (1) 1 member of the Commission selected by the chairman of the Commission and 1 member selected by the chairman of each of the following regional councils or their successor organization from a local government represented on the council:
 - (1) Baltimore Regional Council of Governments;
 - (2) Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments;
 - (3) Frederick County Council of Governments;
 - (4) Tri-County Council for Southern Maryland;
 - (5) Tri County Council for Western Maryland;
 - (6) Wilmington Metropolitan Area Planning Coordinating Council; and
 - (7) Delmarva Advisory Council;
- (2) 5 members recommended by the Maryland Association of Counties who shall be elected county officials representing different regions of the State;
- (3) 3 members recommended by the Maryland Municipal League who shall be elected municipal officials representing different regions of the State;
