- (4) 2 citizen members from different regions of the State; and
- (5) 2 planners employed by local jurisdictions in the State.
- (b) The Subcommittee on Planning shall be composed of a member of the Commission, 2 members of local chapters of the American Planning Association, and 4-ex officio members of county or municipal planning commissions who are elected officials 2 county officials, 1 of whom shall be an elected official, and 2 municipal officials, 1 of whom shall be an elected official, all selected by the Chairman of the Commission, and 4 citizen representatives of local planning commissions, all selected by the Chairman chairman of the Commission.
- (c) The Subcommittee on Planning Techniques shall be composed of a member of the Commission selected by the chairman of the Commission, 2 representatives selected by the Maryland Association of Counties, 2 representatives selected by the Maryland Municipal League, 3 members selected by the Director of Planning including a representative of the private sector planning community, and 2 citizen members selected by the chairman of the Commission.
- (e) (d) The Subcommittee on the Environment and Economic Development shall consist of the following members:
- (1) 1 member of the Commission selected by the chairman of the Commission; and
 - (2) 6 members selected by the Governor as follows:
- (i) 2 members representing the State's environmental interest organizations, selected from a list submitted by the Chesapeake Bay Foundation containing at least 6 names;
- (ii) 2 members representing the State's business interest organizations, selected from a list submitted by the Maryland Chamber and Economic Development Associates, containing at least 6 names; and
- (iii) 2 members representing the State's local governments, <u>1 each from a county and a municipal corporation</u>, selected from lists submitted by the Maryland Municipal League and the Maryland Association of Counties, each list to contain at least 3 names; and
- (iv) 1 member representing the State's agricultural interests, selected from a list submitted by the Maryland Farm Bureau, containing at least 3 names.
- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That of the initial members of the State Economic Growth and Resource, Resource Protection, and Planning Commission, the members recommended by the Maryland Association of Counties, the Maryland Municipal League, and the members from Western Maryland and Central Maryland serve for terms of 4 years; and the members from the Eastern Shore and the Metropolitan Washington area serve terms of 3 years; and the members from Southern Maryland and the Baltimore Metropolitan area and the remaining members appointed by the Governor serve for terms of 2 years.
