SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That by January 1, 1993 each local-jurisdiction which exercises zoning and planning authority shall provide to the Governor—a schedule for complying with the requirements of Article 66B, §§ 3.05(a)(1)(vi) and (viii), 3.06, and 4.09, as enacted by this Act.

SECTION 6. 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on or before October <u>December</u> 1, 1993 the <u>State</u> Economic Growth and Resource, <u>Resource Protection</u>, <u>and Planning</u> Commission shall submit its first annual report <u>with any recommendations</u> required under § 5-708(b) of the State Finance and Procurement Article, as enacted by this Act.

SECTION 7. 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

## **CHAPTER 438**

(Senate Bill 281)

AN ACT concerning

## Criminal Law - False Imprisonment of a Correctional Employee

FOR the purpose of making it a crime for an inmate to falsely imprison a correctional employee; providing certain penalties for a violation of this Act; providing that a sentence imposed under this Act shall run consecutively to the term of confinement; defining certain terms; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to false imprisonment by an inmate of a correctional employee.

## Preamble

WHEREAS, There is currently no specific provision making it illegal for an inmate to take a correctional employee as a hostage; and
