(III) PERIODICALLY DISTRIBUTING TO THE PUBLIC A CURRENT LISTING OF THE NAMES, ADDRESSES, AND TELEPHONE NUMBERS OF CONSUMER REPORTING AGENCIES THAT MAINTAIN INFORMATION OR PROVIDE CONSUMER REPORTS ON RESIDENTS OF THE STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 442

(Senate Bill 37)

AN ACT concerning

Mercuric Oxide Batteries and Nickel Cadmium Batteries - Recycling and Disposal

FOR the purpose of prohibiting disposal of certain batteries after a certain date except as approved by the Department of the Environment under regulations adopted by the Department; requiring the Office of Recycling, in conjunction with certain persons, to develop certain programs by a certain date for the recycling and disposal of certain batteries prohibiting, on or after a certain date, a person from selling, offering for sale, or offering for promotional purposes in the State certain batteries unless the manufacturer of the product has obtained certain approval of the Department of a certain battery management plan; establishing the responsibility of certain battery manufacturers for certain collection, transportation, and recycling or proper disposal of certain batteries produced by the manufacturer and sold or offered for certain purposes in the State; allowing certain retailers or sellers to provide for certain collection, recycling, or disposal of certain batteries under certain circumstances; setting forth certain requirements for certain battery management plans; providing a penalty; and generally relating to the recycling and disposal of certain batteries.
