- (E) A MANUFACTURER MAY SHALL CONSULT WITH THE OFFICE OF RECYCLING IN DEVELOPING ITS PLAN AND, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE OPERATOR OF A RECYCLING SYSTEM, WHERE APPROPRIATE, MAY DEVELOP ITS PLAN IN COOPERATION WITH AN EXISTING RECYCLING SYSTEM.
- (F) EACH BATTERY MANAGEMENT PLAN SUBMITTED BY A MANUFACTURER SHALL INCLUDE:
- (1) THE DESIGNATION OF THE COLLECTOR, TRANSPORTER, PROCESSOR, OR COLLECTION SYSTEM TO BE UTILIZED BY THE MANUFACTURER, OR BY THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, INSTITUTIONAL GENERATOR, RETAILER OR SMALL QUANTITY GENERATOR ON BEHALF OF THE MANUFACTURER, FOR THE COLLECTION, TRANSPORTATION, AND RECYCLING OR PROPER DISPOSAL OF USED MERCURIC OXIDE BATTERIES OR USED NICKEL CADMIUM BATTERIES IN EACH COUNTY;
- (2) THE DESIGNATION OF THE FUNDING SOURCE OR MECHANISM TO BE USED BY THE MANUFACTURER TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF IMPLEMENTING THE BATTERY MANAGEMENT PLAN; AND
- (3) A STRATEGY FOR INFORMING CONSUMERS, ON ANY STORE DISPLAY PROMOTING THE SALE OR USE OF THE BATTERIES THE MANUFACTURER MANUFACTURES, THAT THESE TYPES OF USED DRY CELL BATTERIES MAY NOT ENTER THE SOLID WASTE STREAM, AND THAT A CONVENIENT MECHANISM FOR THE COLLECTION, TRANSPORTATION, AND RECYCLING OR PROPER DISPOSAL OF THESE TYPES OF USED BATTERIES IS AVAILABLE TO THE CONSUMER.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES § 6–801(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$100 FOR EACH VIOLATION.
