(2) <u>AUTHENTICATE ANY QUESTIONABLE OR CHALLENGED</u> IDENTIFICATION FORM;

- (2) (3) [Place the authenticated] KEEP THE VERIFIED identification form and sealed ballot envelope [in separate places,] for safekeeping pending the count of the vote;
- (3) (4) Keep <u>SEPARATE</u> any questionable or challenged identification form with the sealed <u>AND</u> ballot until the authentication, <u>VERIFICATION</u>, or challenge is resolved:
- (4) (5) Determine that each eligible voter does not vote more than once; and
- (5) (6) After the time set in subsection [(f)(3)] (F)(2) of this section, tally the votes and report the results to the [president] EXECUTIVE OFFICER BOARD OF DIRECTORS.
- (h) The [president] EXECUTIVE OFFICER BOARD OF DIRECTORS of the credit union shall report the results of the election at the annual meeting of the members.
- (a) Subject to the applicable provisions of the bylaws, the board of directors may expel any member of the credit union who:
- (1) [Fails to meet an] DEFAULTS ON THE PAYMENT OF ANY MONETARY obligation to the credit union;
- (2) Is convicted of a criminal offense INVOLVING DISHONESTY OR BREACH OF TRUST;
- (3) Neglects or refuses to comply with the provisions of this title or of the bylaws of the credit union; ΘT
 - (4) Habitually neglects to pay debts or becomes insolvent or bankrupt; OR
- (5) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, VIOLATES A WRITTEN EXPULSION POLICY ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS.
- (b) A member may withdraw from a credit union or a nonmember may withdraw deposits as the bylaws provide.
- (C) (1) THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS SHALL POST CONSPICUOUSLY AT EACH OFFICE OF THE CREDIT UNION A NOTICE OF ANY EXPULSION POLICY ADOPTED BY THE BOARD.
- (2) A PERSON EXPELLED BY THE BOARD MAY REQUEST A RECONSIDERATION OF THE EXPULSION.
