(2) Within 10 days after the Board receives the amount paid under paragraph (1) of this subsection, the Board shall distribute that amount equally to those pilots who, at the beginning of the month for which the payment is made, were eligible for payments as inactive or permanently disabled pilots.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 449

(Senate Bill 81)

AN ACT concerning

Home Improvement Commission - Issuance of Licenses

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Maryland Home Improvement Commission from issuing a license to an applicant for a contractor, subcontractor, or salesperson license who has been convicted of violating a certain provision of law; specifying a certain exception; and generally relating to the issuance of licenses by the Maryland Home Improvement Commission.

Annotated Code of Maryland

(As enacted by Chapter ____ (S.B. 1) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1992)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Regulation

8-306.

- (a) The Commission shall issue a license to each applicant who meets the requirements of this subtitle.
 - (b) The Commission:
 - (1) may issue a salesperson license only to an individual; and
- (2) may not issue a salesperson license unless the Commission has received from a licensed contractor written notice, signed by both the licensed contractor and salesperson, of an employment or other contractual relationship between the licensed contractor and salesperson.
