(e) An insurer may not refuse to underwrite any private passenger motor vehicle insurance risk solely because USE AS AN UNDERWRITING CRITERION, AS A BASIS FOR REFUSING TO UNDERWRITE ANY PRIVATE PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE RISK, THE FACT THAT refuse to underwrite any private passenger motor vehicle insurance risk solely because the applicant or named insured previously obtained insurance coverage from ANY AUTHORIZED INSURER OR the Maryland Automobile Insurance Fund.
