

(ii) Any person being touched, caressed or fondled on the breast, buttocks, anus or genitals.

(iii) Scenes where a person displays the vulva or anus or the genitals.

(iv) Scenes where artificial devices or inanimate objects are employed to depict, or drawings are employed to portray, any of the prohibited activities described above.

(4) Permitting any person to remain in or upon the licensed premises who exposes to public view any portion of his genitals or anus.

[(b)](C) A provision of this section does not permit any conduct or form of attire prohibited by any other provision of statute, ordinance, rule or regulation [in Anne Arundel County, Calvert County, Carroll County, Cecil County, Charles County, Harford County, St. Mary's County, and Worcester County].

[(c)](D) In Cecil County, in addition to the penalty provided in subsection [(a)] (B) of this section, if any of the activities listed in subsection [(a)] (B) of this section are found to occur on the premises for which the license was issued, the holder of the license, or any employee, entertainer, or patron who performs any of the listed activities, [shall be] IS guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined or imprisoned according to the penalty set forth in § 200 of this article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 464

(Senate Bill 287)

AN ACT concerning

Cecil County – Home Detention

FOR the purpose of requiring the Sheriff of Cecil County to establish and administer a home detention program; requiring the Sheriff to adopt rules and regulations to implement the home detention program; establishing certain eligibility requirements for individuals placed in the home detention program; permitting the Sheriff or sentencing judge to place an individual in the home detention program under certain circumstances; requiring the Sheriff to determine the amount of, and collect from individuals in the home detention program, a certain fee; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the establishment of a home detention program in Cecil County.

BY adding to

Article 27 – Crimes and Punishments
