

(G) IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION, THE CECIL COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION, ON REQUEST OF THE CECIL COUNTY BOARD OF ESTIMATES, SHALL PROVIDE WITH THE ANNUAL BUDGET SEPARATE INFORMATION ON THE NUMBER OF AND COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH SCHOOL-BASED NONINSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 473

(Senate Bill 392)

AN ACT concerning

The Maryland Horse Racing — ~~Satellite Simulcast Betting~~ Act of 1992

FOR the purpose of requiring a person to hold a satellite simulcast betting permit granted by the State Racing Commission before holding satellite simulcast betting in the State; specifying certain factors that the Commission shall consider in deciding whether to grant a permit; requiring the Commission to conduct a personal and financial background check of an applicant for a permit under certain circumstances; requiring the Commission to set the term of each permit; specifying that a permit does not give the permit holder certain ownership rights; allowing the Commission to approve the transfer of a permit under certain circumstances; requiring a permit holder to keep certain records and submit certain annual reports; specifying that certain denial of license and disciplinary provisions apply to permit applicants and holders; specifying certain requirements concerning ownership, location, hours of operation, and physical characteristics of satellite simulcast facilities; requiring certain requirements concerning the ownership and operation of pari-mutuel betting equipment; requiring certain licensees to submit certain contracts and agreements to the Commission; requiring the Commission to be assured of continuing compliance with certain provisions of law; permitting the Commission to enter certain facilities; authorizing the Commission to impose certain penalties; allowing certain persons to allocate among themselves certain costs of satellite simulcast betting; specifying the disposition of all money bet at a satellite simulcast facility; requiring that a satellite simulcast facility transmit certain information to a sending track; prohibiting certain facilities from conducting satellite simulcast betting at certain times except under certain circumstances; prohibiting certain facilities from lending or giving money; requiring that the State Racing Commission report annually to the Legislative Policy Committee on satellite simulcast betting; requiring the State Racing Commission to adopt certain regulations; removing certain restrictions on holding pari-mutuel betting in the State on races at certain out-of-state tracks; providing that certain fees shall be
