THE COMMISSION SHALL REPORT TO THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE OF THE MARYLAND GENERAL ASSEMBLY ANNUALLY BY THE OPENING DAY OF THE LEGISLATIVE SESSION ON:

(1) THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THIS PART; AND

(2) THE EFFECT OF SATELLITE SIMULCAST BETTING ON THE RACING INDUSTRY IN THE STATE.

THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO:

(1) DEFINE THE CRITERIA FOR APPLICANTS FOR A SATELLITE SIMULCAST BETTING PERMIT, WHICH MAY INCLUDE A NONREFUNDABLE APPLICATION FEE;

(2) DEFINE ALLOWABLE COSTS OF OPERATIONS UNDER ~~§ 11-826~~ § 11-827 OF THIS PART; AND

(3) OTHERWISE CARRY OUT THIS PART.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992, and remain in effect until the taking effect of Section 2.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992, contingent on the taking effect of Chapter ____ (S.B. 1) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1992. However, if Chapter ____ (S.B. 1) does not become effective, then Section 2 of this Act shall not take effect and shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.

Practice of Podiatry - Definition and Requirements

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "practice podiatry" to include the diagnosis, or surgical, medical, or mechanical treatment of any ailment of the human ankle and certain other related structures; excluding certain procedures from the definition of "practice podiatry" ~~subject to certain conditions; requiring licensed podiatrists to complete a certain program in order to perform certain procedures;~~ requiring a licensed podiatrist to perform certain surgical procedures of the ankle in a licensed hospital and subject to certain provisions; authorizing
