

(viii) Subject to the provisions of subparagraph (xi) of this paragraph, for a resident to catch any fish in tidal waters by any methods which are lawful under Subtitles 2, 7, 8, 9, and 10 \$300

(ix) To buy, process, pack, resell, market, or otherwise deal in fish caught in tidal waters, as required under Subtitles 7, 8, 9, and 10\$150

(x) To allow a commercial finfish licensee to place that license in an inactive status.....\$5

(xi) To catch for sale striped bass with a license issued under subparagraph (ii) and (viii) of this paragraph, the licensee shall pay a fee equal to the difference between the annual fee of the applicable license and \$250.

(k) (1) In addition to the normal license fees imposed under § 4-701(d)(1)(ii), (iv), (VI), (vii), (VIII), and (ix) of this subtitle, the Department shall annually assess a surcharge of \$10.

(2) The surcharge required under this subsection shall be:

(i) Collected by the Department;

(ii) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (3) of this subsection, credited to the Seafood Marketing Office of the Department of Agriculture; and

(iii) Used only for marketing programs of the Seafood Marketing Office.

(3) Before transferring the surcharges collected under this subsection, the Department shall review each marketing proposal of the Marketing Office that will be funded by these surcharges.

(4) The surcharge collected under this subsection shall be in addition to and not in place of general funds appropriated to the Seafood Marketing Office.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~October~~ September 1, 1992.

AN ACT concerning

Unauthorized Signatures and Alterations – Customer's Duty to Discover and Report

FOR the purpose of clarifying that customers of financial institutions have a duty to discover and report unauthorized signatures or alterations on items *or facsimiles* paid by the financial institution under certain circumstances; and generally relating
