CHAPTER 492

(Senate Bill 565)

AN ACT concerning

Horse Racing – Prohibition Against Lending Money

FOR the purpose of expanding the prohibition against lending money for pari-mutuel betting to encompass all entities licensed to hold horse racing.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – Business Regulation

Section 11-802(a)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(As enacted by Chapter ____ (S.B. 1) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1992)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Business Regulation

11-802.

(a) A [harness racing] licensee[, a mile thoroughbred racing licensee, or the Maryland State Fair and Agricultural Society, Inc.,] may not lend or give money to a person for pari-mutuel betting.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.
