

CHAPTER 493

(Senate Bill 568)

AN ACT concerning

Education – Maryland School for the Deaf – Board of Trustees – Admission of Out-of-State Students – Payment of Tuition

FOR the purpose of vesting the government of the Maryland School for the Deaf in the Board of Trustees for the Maryland School for the Deaf; establishing the composition of the Board of Trustees; providing for the appointment of members to the Board of Trustees; specifying the powers and duties of the Board of Trustees; repealing provisions relating to the Board of Visitors of the Maryland School for the Deaf and a requirement that certain services be provided free of charge; terminating the Board of Visitors; authorizing the Maryland School for the Deaf to admit out-of-state students and to charge tuition to out-of-state students; requiring the Maryland School for the Deaf to adopt certain standards for certain students; requiring the Maryland School for the Deaf to admit free of charge certain students; requiring certain local education agencies to notify certain individuals of the availability of certain programs; specifying the terms of office of the initial members of the Board of Trustees; requiring the appropriation of a certain gift fund balance to the Board of Trustees by a certain date; and generally relating to the establishment of the Board of Trustees of the Maryland School for the Deaf and the admission of and payment of tuition by out-of-state students to the Maryland School for the Deaf.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 6 of Chapter 247 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1867 be repealed.
