

~~(B)~~ (G) (1) There is a branch of the Maryland School for the Deaf.

(2) This branch shall be located near the population center of this State.

(3) The branch shall be administered and operated as part of and is subject to the Maryland School for the Deaf.

~~(C)~~ (H) (1) THE MARYLAND SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF SHALL ADOPT WRITTEN STANDARDS FOR THE ADMISSION OF STUDENTS.

(2) THE STANDARDS SHALL DEFINE AND DISTINGUISH BETWEEN STUDENTS WHO ARE BONA FIDE MARYLAND RESIDENTS AND THOSE WHO ARE OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS, FOR PURPOSES OF ADMISSION AND TUITION.

~~(D)~~ (I) THE MARYLAND SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF SHALL ADMIT FREE OF CHARGE STUDENTS WHO:

(1) ARE BONA FIDE MARYLAND RESIDENTS; AND

(2) MEET ITS ADMISSION STANDARDS.

~~(E)~~ (J) (1) THE MARYLAND SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF MAY ADMIT FOR TUITION OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS WHO MEET ITS ADMISSION STANDARDS.

(2) THE SCHOOL SHALL ESTABLISH TUITION RATES ON AN ANNUAL BASIS.

EACH LOCAL EDUCATION AGENCY IN THE STATE SHALL NOTIFY THE PARENTS OR GUARDIANS OF EACH HEARING IMPAIRED CHILD OF THE AVAILABILITY OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS OFFERED BY THE MARYLAND SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the trustees serving on the Board of Trustees beginning October 1, 1992, shall expire as follows:

(1) 6 trustees in 1997;

(2) 7 trustees in 1998; and

(3) 6 trustees in 1996.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That any balance in the Maryland School for the Deaf Gift Fund held by the State Treasurer on October 1, 1992 shall be appropriated to the Board of Trustees of the Maryland School for the Deaf. Fund balances shall be established by the 1992 fiscal year financial statement prepared by the Maryland School for the Deaf, issued by their independent auditors, and accepted by the Comptroller.
