FOR the purpose of providing that a minor does not have the capacity to refuse treatment for drug abuse or alcoholism under certain circumstances; ~~establishing that certain child care licensing provisions do not apply to certain drug and alcohol treatment programs; authorizing a parent or guardian of a minor to apply for admission of the minor to an a certified inpatient alcohol and drug abuse program or facility under certain circumstances; establishing certain requirements for the admission and retention for treatment of an individual by a program or facility; providing for the termination of this Act;~~ and generally relating to drug and alcohol treatment programs for minors.
