~~(2)~~ (3) AN APPLICATION FOR A TRANSIENT VENDOR'S LICENSE SHALL BE IN THE FORM AND CONTAIN THE INFORMATION THAT THE COMPTROLLER REQUIRES BY REGULATION.

~~(3)~~ (4) A LICENSE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL ~~BE RENEWED ANNUALLY.~~ BE VALID FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS.

(5) THE COMPTROLLER MAY NOT RENEW A LICENSE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION UNLESS THE TRANSIENT VENDOR HAS A SALES AND USE TAX LICENSE AND ANY NECESSARY TRADER'S LICENSE AND HAS PAID ALL STATE TAXES.

(B) A TRANSIENT VENDOR SHALL:

~~(1) KEEP A TRANSIENT VENDOR'S LICENSE IN ITS POSSESSION AT ALL TIMES WHEN CONDUCTING BUSINESS IN THE STATE; AND~~

~~(2) EXHIBIT THE LICENSE ON DEMAND OF ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER SHALL DISPLAY THE TRANSIENT VENDOR'S LICENSE AT EACH TRANSIENT PLACE OF BUSINESS.~~

~~(C) THE TRANSIENT VENDOR'S LICENSE SHALL STATE THAT THE TRANSIENT VENDOR NAMED IN THE LICENSE AS A LICENSED TRANSIENT VENDOR AND SHALL PROVIDE NOTICE TO THE TRANSIENT VENDOR THAT:~~

~~(1) BEFORE ENTERING THE STATE TO CONDUCT BUSINESS, THE TRANSIENT VENDOR MUST NOTIFY THE COMPTROLLER, IN WRITING, OF THE LOCATION OR LOCATIONS WHERE IT INTENDS TO CONDUCT BUSINESS AND THE DATE OR DATES ON WHICH IT INTENDS TO CONDUCT BUSINESS;~~

~~(2) FAILURE TO NOTIFY OR GIVING FALSE INFORMATION TO THE COMPTROLLER MAY RESULT IN SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF THE TRANSIENT VENDOR'S LICENSE; AND~~

~~(3) CONDUCTING BUSINESS WITHIN THE STATE WITHOUT POSSESSING A VALID AND EFFECTIVE LICENSE MAY RESULT IN CRIMINAL CONVICTION AND THE IMPOSITION OF FINES OR OTHER PENALTIES BE ON THE FORM SPECIFIED BY THE COMPTROLLER.~~
