TITLE 10. MOTOR FUEL AND LUBRICANTS.

SUBTITLE 1. DEFINITIONS.

10-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS TITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) CONVEYANCE.

(1) "CONVEYANCE" MEANS A CARRYING OR TRANSPORTING DEVICE THAT HAS A CAPACITY THAT EXCEEDS 50 GALLONS EXCLUSIVE OF THE FUEL SUPPLY TANK FOR ITS OWN PROPULSION.

(2) "CONVEYANCE" INCLUDES A PIPELINE, TANK CAR, VEHICLE, AND VESSEL.

(3) "CONVEYANCE" DOES NOT INCLUDE A CARRYING OR TRANSPORTING DEVICE WITH A CAPACITY OF LESS THAN 300 GALLONS THAT A FARMER USES WHILE ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF FARMING.

(C) GASOLINE.

(1) "GASOLINE" MEANS A PRODUCT THAT:

(I) IS USED AS FUEL IN A SPARK IGNITED, INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINE; OR

(II) IS DESIGNATED AS GASOLINE BY THE COMPTROLLER.
