

(I) RECEIPT OF THE NOTICE OF CANCELLATION IF THE PURCHASER'S AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE IS MADE AT A PLACE OTHER THAN THE PLACE OF BUSINESS OF THE SELLER; OR

(II) RETURN OF THE HEARING AID, IF THE PURCHASER'S AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE IS MADE AT THE PLACE OF BUSINESS OF THE SELLER.

14-2405.

(A) IF A SELLER VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE BUYER MAY CANCEL THE SALE BY NOTIFYING THE SELLER, IN ANY MANNER AND BY ANY MEANS, OF THE BUYER'S INTENTION TO CANCEL.

(B) IF A SELLER FAILS TO REFUND ALL PAYMENTS IN THE TIME REQUIRED, AFTER THE PURCHASE COMPLIES WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE NOTICE OF CANCELLATION A PURCHASER IS ENTITLED TO PAYMENT OF AN ADDITIONAL ~~40~~ 1 PERCENT FOR EACH MONTH OR PART OF A MONTH THAT THE REFUND IS NOT PAID.

VIOLATION OF THIS ACT IS:

- (1) AN UNFAIR AND DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICE; AND
- (2) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 13 OF THIS ARTICLE.

WHILE PRACTICING AUDIOLOGY, A PERSON MAY NOT:

- (1) ENGAGE IN AN UNFAIR OR DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICE, AS DEFINED IN § 13-301 OF THE COMMERCIAL LAW ARTICLE; OR
- (2) VIOLATE ANY PROVISION OF TITLE 14, SUBTITLE 24 OF THE COMMERCIAL LAW ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.
