SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Environment

7-201.

(x) (2) “Responsible person” does not include:

(v) A [corporate] fiduciary [which] WHO has legal title to a site containing a hazardous substance or to property located on the site containing a hazardous substance for purpose of administering an estate or trust of which the site or property located on the site is a part unless the [corporate] fiduciary:

1. Participates in the day-to-day management of the site or property; or
2. Directly causes the discharge of a hazardous substance on or from the site;

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a presently existing obligation or contract right may not be impaired in any way by this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.
