

3. The licensee has not been convicted of any other moving violation or criminal offense involving a motor vehicle, regardless of the number of suspensions or revocations.

(c) The Administration may refuse to expunge a driving record if it determines that the individual requesting the expungement has not driven a motor vehicle on the highways during the particular conviction-free period on which the request is based.

(D) THE ADMINISTRATION ~~MAY~~ SHALL EXPUNGE FROM ITS DRIVER RECORD DATA BASE THE DRIVING RECORD OF AN INDIVIDUAL:

(1) WHO HAS NOT BEEN CONVICTED OF A MOVING VIOLATION OR CRIMINAL OFFENSE INVOLVING A MOTOR VEHICLE FOR THE PRECEDING 3 YEARS;

(2) WHO HAS NOT BEEN CONVICTED OF, OR BEEN GRANTED PROBATION BEFORE JUDGMENT FOR, A VIOLATION OF § 21-902 OF THIS ARTICLE OR A MOVING VIOLATION IDENTICAL OR SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO § 21-902 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND

(3) WHOSE LICENSE OR PRIVILEGE TO DRIVE NEVER HAS BEEN SUSPENDED OR REVOKED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

AN ACT concerning

Horse Racing - Horsemen's Organizations — Elections

FOR the purpose of ~~authorizing organizations to petition the State Racing Commission to represent certain thoroughbred horsemen or standardbred horsemen in the State; specifying the contents and notice requirements for petitions; specifying certain procedures the Commission must follow to hold an election to determine representation; setting requirements to determine the eligibility of voters and the validity of ballots; requiring that certain money be held in escrow until the result of an election is determined; requiring the Commission to set an approximate cutoff date for completed ballots to be received by the Commission; specifying the contents of ballots; specifying that the organization receiving the largest number of votes cast is to be designated the organization representing the majority of thoroughbred horsemen or standardbred horsemen; establishing certain procedures for election challenges; specifying certain conditions for the release of certain money held in escrow; changing the composition of certain organizations at certain~~
