SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 78B – Racing Commission

(a) (2) “Horsemen’s organization” means:

(i) For a track licensed under § 17 of this article, a group which represents a majority of the horsemen AND DRIVERS at a particular track ~~or~~ AND a majority of the applicable breeders in this State for tracks licensed under § 17 of this article; and

(ii) For a track licensed under § 7 of this article, a group which represents a majority of the horsemen at a particular track and a majority of the applicable breeders in this State.
