

(I) AN INSTRUMENT OF WRITING EXEMPT FROM THE STATE TRANSFER TAX UNDER § 13-207 OF THE TAX - PROPERTY ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND;

(II) A TRANSFER OF LAND SUBJECT TO THE AGRICULTURAL LAND TRANSFER TAX UNDER TITLE 13, SUBTITLE 3 OF THE TAX - PROPERTY ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND; OR

(III) THE FIRST \$50,000 OF THE CONSIDERATION PAYABLE FOR AN INSTRUMENT OF WRITING FOR THE TRANSFERRED REAL PROPERTY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

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## CHAPTER 545

(House Bill 534)

AN ACT concerning

### **Workers' Compensation - Benefits for Permanent Partial Disability - Extension of Sunset Provision**

FOR the purpose of delaying the termination of certain changes to the benefit structure for permanent partial disability in order to continue to exempt loss of the thumb, fingers, and great toe from the lower tier of benefits; and generally relating to delaying the termination of certain changes to the benefit structure for permanent partial disability.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Chapter 591 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1987, as amended by Chapter 11 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1989 and Chapter 97 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1990
