(G) PRODUCER.

"PRODUCER" MEANS A COMPANY, OR AGENT, PARENT COMPANY, SUBSIDIARY, OR JOINT VENTURE OF A COMPANY, THAT EXTRACTS CRUDE OIL FROM THE EARTH.

(H) REFINER.

"REFINER" MEANS A PERSON WHO MAKES MOTOR FUEL FROM CRUDE OIL BY CHANGING THE PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE CRUDE OIL.

(I) RETAIL SERVICE STATION DEALER.

"RETAIL SERVICE STATION DEALER" MEANS A PERSON WHO OPERATES A RETAIL PLACE OF BUSINESS WHERE MOTOR FUEL IS SOLD AND DELIVERED INTO THE FUEL SUPPLY TANKS OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 157A(4). It is similar to TG § 9-301(r).

The word "retail" is added to modify "place of business" for clarity.

The reference to "motor fuel" is substituted for the former reference to "motor vehicle fuel" to obviate the need for a separate definition of that term. Although, as used in this revision, "gasoline" includes aviation gasoline, an exclusion for that type of gasoline is unnecessary in this subsection in light of the specific reference to delivery into the fuel tanks of "motor vehicles".

(J) SPECIAL FUEL.

(1) "SPECIAL FUEL" MEANS A PRODUCT THAT IS USABLE AS FUEL IN AN INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINE.

(2) "SPECIAL FUEL" DOES NOT INCLUDE GASOLINE.
