

(iii) Consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be restricted to the premises.

(n) The licenses shall be issued only in:

(17) THE Town of Ocean City AND THE OTHER AREAS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (J) OF THIS SECTION in Worcester County.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 550

(House Bill 636)

AN ACT concerning

Natural Resources – Critical Areas – Impervious Surface Limitations

FOR the purpose of providing that a local jurisdiction may grant a variance from certain impervious surface limitations under the critical areas laws under certain circumstances.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – Natural Resources

Section 8-1808.3

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1990 Replacement Volume and 1991 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Natural Resources

8-1808.3.

(a) This section applies notwithstanding:

(1) Any other provision of this subtitle; or

(2) Any criteria or guideline of the Commission adopted under this subtitle.

(b) This section controls over any other requirement concerning impervious surfaces limitations in limited development areas and resource conservation areas in the critical area.

(c) On or before December 31, 1990, a local jurisdiction shall amend its local critical area protection program to meet the provisions of this section.
