FOR the purpose of requiring the Child Support Enforcement Administration and local support enforcement offices, subject to certain laws or programs, to promote and serve the best interests of the child in carrying out certain responsibilities.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Family Law

10-118.

~~IN CARRYING OUT THEIR CHILD SUPPORT RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS SUBTITLE SUBJECT TO ANY FEDERAL LAW OR PROGRAM, THE ADMINISTRATION AND LOCAL SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT OFFICES SHALL PROMOTE AND SERVE THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE CHILD IN CARRYING OUT THEIR CHILD SUPPORT RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.~~
