

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the State Board of Dental Examiners shall conduct a thorough review of the needs of underprivileged citizens of Maryland, especially the elderly, children, economically underprivileged, and handicapped for improved access to quality dental care and evaluate to what extent, if any, a broadening of the waiver of supervision requirements under § 4-308(d)(2) of the Health Occupations Article can be used to safely improve access to quality dental care for these Maryland citizens. On or before December 1, 1992 the Board and, if necessary, the Committee on Dental Hygiene as well, shall submit to the House Environmental Matters Committee and Senate Economic and Environmental Affairs Committee a report of its findings and recommendations under this section.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on or before December 1, 1994 the State Board of Dental Examiners and its Committee on Dental Hygiene shall submit a report jointly, or separately if necessary, to the House Environmental Matters Committee and the Senate Economic and Environmental Affairs Committee that details:

- (1) The character and magnitude of matters referred to the Committee on Dental Hygiene by the Board;
- (2) The recommendations the Committee on Dental Hygiene made to the Board;
and
- (3) The action taken by the Board on the recommendations made by the Committee on Dental Hygiene to the Board.

~~SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the 2 additional dental hygienist members of the Board required to be appointed under § 1 of this Act shall be appointed to replace the first 2 dentist members whose terms expire on or after the effective date of this Act.~~

~~SECTION 3. 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992.~~

FOR the purpose of ~~repealing~~ extending a certain termination date for the Prince George's County energy tax; requiring Prince George's County to appropriate local funds to the school operating budget for each fiscal year in a certain minimum amount; requiring certain information relating to education financing; providing for the
