CHAPTER 572

(House Bill 913)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission - Minority Business Enterprise Utilization Program

PG/MC 28-92

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) to establish a minority business enterprise utilization program for the award of contracts for goods, services, and construction under certain circumstances; requiring the Commission to adopt certain regulations for operating the minority business enterprise utilization program; defining a term; requiring a certain report by a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; making provisions of this Act severable; providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally relating to a minority business enterprise utilization program under the M-NCPPC.

BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission

Subtitle 3. Minority Business Enterprise UTILIZATION Program [Study]

(a) The Commission shall undertake and complete an internal and market fact-finding study to assess the appropriate scope of a minority business enterprise program for the Commission.
