SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Natural Resources

5-901.

(a) In this subtitle the following terms have the meanings indicated.

(c) “Funds available under this program” means the proceeds of Program Open Space and the annual apportionment of allocation of the Land and Water Conservation Fund to the State by the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Outdoor Recreation.

(e) “Local governing body” means the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission and the governing body of any county or Baltimore City.

(f) “Local projects” means acquisition or development of projects sponsored by the local governing bodies or their units, and in the case of Baltimore City it also means operation and maintenance of projects as provided in subsection (i) of this section.

(g) “Municipal corporation” means the incorporated towns of the State as defined in Article XI-E of the Maryland Constitution.
