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## CHAPTER 576

(House Bill 945)

AN ACT concerning

### **Baltimore City – Alcoholic Beverages Licenses Limitation**

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the issuance or transfers of certain alcoholic beverages licenses within a certain described area in Baltimore City.

BY adding to

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

Section 53C(i)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1990 Replacement Volume and 1991 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

53C.

(I) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS OF BALTIMORE CITY MAY NOT ISSUE ANY NEW CLASS A (OFF-SALE) OR CLASS D (ON- AND OFF-SALE) ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSES WITHIN OR TRANSFER ANY CLASS A (OFF-SALE) OR CLASS D (ON- AND OFF-SALE) ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSES INTO THE AREA BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY 39TH STREET THEN FOLLOWING ELLERSLIE AVENUE, THEN FOLLOWING CHESTNUT HILL AVENUE, ON THE EAST BY LOCH RAVEN BOULEVARD THEN FOLLOWING WALPERT AVENUE AND THEN FOLLOWING HOMEWOOD AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH BY NORTH AVENUE, AND ON THE
