CHAPTER 577

(House Bill 952)

AN ACT concerning

Boiler and Pressure Vessel Safety

FOR the purpose of continuing the Board of Boiler Rules in accordance with the Maryland Program Evaluation Act by extending to a certain date the termination provision relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the Board and the regulation of boiler and pressure vessels; adding a member to the Board who is a stationary engineer; requiring the Board to adopt certain safety standards by regulation; requiring certain individuals who install boiler or pressure vessels to give certain notice to the Commissioner; imposing a civil penalty for a certain act; making certain stylistic changes; imposing a certain test for conviction of persons guilty of certain violations; deleting an obsolete reference to the Annotated Code; and generally relating to boiler and pressure vessel safety.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 48 – Inspections

Section 169, 170, 176(e), 178A, and 180A

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1991 Replacement Volume and 1991 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 48 – Inspections

169.

There is hereby created within the Division of Labor and Industry a Board of Boiler Rules, referred to hereafter as the "Board," consisting of [seven] EIGHT members, which shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice of the Secretary of Licensing and Regulation, and with the advice and consent of the Senate. Among the members of the Board shall be one representative of the owners and users of power boilers, one representative of owners and users of heating boilers, one representative of owners and users of pressure vessels, one representative of manufacturers or assemblers of boilers or pressure vessels, one representative of a company licensed to insure boilers or pressure
