SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Occupations and Professions

15-101.

(a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.

(K) "RESPONSIBLE CHARGE" MEANS DIRECT CONTROL AND PERSONAL DIRECTION OF THE INVESTIGATION, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, OR OPERATION OF LAND SURVEYING WORK THAT REQUIRES INITIATIVE, PROFESSIONAL SKILL, AND INDEPENDENT JUDGMENT.

(b) In addition to any duties set forth elsewhere, the Board shall:

(1) adopt a seal;

(2) determine a type of marker, monument, stake, or other landmark that a licensee shall use in practicing land surveying and practicing property line surveying; [and]

(3) keep a record of its proceedings; AND

(4) BY REGULATION, FORMALIZE MINIMUM STANDARDS OF PRACTICE FOR LICENSEES.

15-305.

(a) In addition to the other qualifications for a license to practice land surveying, an applicant shall qualify under this section by meeting the educational and experience requirements set forth in subsection (b), (c), or (d) of this section.

(b) (1) An applicant qualifies under this section if the applicant:

(i) has been graduated from a college or university on completion of at least a 4-year curriculum in engineering or land surveying, or their equivalent, that the Board approves;
