(31) FAILS TO <u>BEGIN TO</u> FULFILL A PUBLIC SERVICE REQUIREMENT <u>WITHIN 1 YEAR OF WHEN THE ASSIGNMENT IS TO BEGIN</u> THAT WAS A CONDITION OF THE LICENSEE RECEIVING STATE OR FEDERAL LOANS OR SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE LICENSEE'S MEDICAL EDUCATION.

15-314.

Subject to the hearing provisions of § 15-315 of this subtitle, the Board, on the affirmative vote of a majority of its members then serving, may reprimand any certificate holder or suspend or revoke a certificate if the certificate holder:

- (5) Performs delegated medical acts without the supervision of a physician; [or]
- (6) Refuses, withholds from, denies, or discriminates against an individual with regard to the provision of professional services for which the licensee is licensed and qualified to render because the individual is HIV positive; OR
- (7) FAILS TO BEGIN TO FULFILL A PUBLIC SERVICE REQUIREMENT WITHIN 1 YEAR OF WHEN THE ASSIGNMENT IS TO BEGIN THAT WAS A CONDITION OF THE APPLICANT OR CERTIFICATE HOLDER RECEIVING STATE OF FEDERAL LOANS OR SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE APPLICANT'S OR CERTIFICATE HOLDER'S PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT EDUCATION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14-404.

- (a) Subject to the hearing provisions of § 14–405 of this subtitle, the Board, on the affirmative vote of a majority of its full authorized membership, may reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the licensee:
- (30) Refuses, withholds from, denies, or discriminates against an individual with regard to the provision of professional services for which the licensee is licensed and qualified to render because the individual is HIV positive; [or]
- (31) Except as to an association that has remained in continuous existence since July 1, 1963:
- (i) Associates with a pharmacist as a partner or co-owner of a pharmacy for the purpose of operating a pharmacy;
- (ii) Employs a pharmacist for the purpose of operating a pharmacy; [or]
- (iii) Contracts with a pharmacist for the purpose of operating a pharmacy; OR
