(i) (3) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY NOT ACCEPT AN APPLICATION FOR ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY FILED BY A MEMBER OR FORMER MEMBER MORE THAN 5 YEARS AFTER THE DATE OF THE CLAIMED ACCIDENT UNLESS THE MEMBER OR FORMER MEMBER PROVES TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE MEDICAL BOARD THAT FAILURE TO FILE WITHIN THE REQUIRED 5 YEARS WAS ATTRIBUTABLE SOLELY TO PHYSICAL OR MENTAL CONDITIONS THAT RESULTED DIRECTLY FROM THE EVENT OR ACT OF DUTY THAT CAUSED THE DISABILITY.
