- (2) THE HOLDER OF THIS LICENSE IS AUTHORIZED TO SELL BEER:
 - (I) FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION ONLY; AND
- (II) DURING THE HOURS AND DAYS ESTABLISHED FOR THIS LICENSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 587

(House Bill 1078)

AN ACT concerning

Code Home Rule Counties Worcester County - Water and Sewer Services - Straw Poll

FOR the purpose of authorizing the county commissioners of a code home rule county to establish and assign certain duties to a department of public facilities and services; requiring the county commissioners to abolish certain entities if responsibility for water-and-sewerage service is assigned to the department; specifying certain requirements concerning the abolishment of certain entities; authorizing the county commissioners to request certain information; providing that, if the county commissioners abolish certain entities, the county commissioners exercise certain powers; authorizing the county commissioners of a code-home rule county, subject to a certain condition, to enter into an agreement under the terms of which a municipal corporation will assume responsibility for water or sewerage services; requiring the agreement to meet certain requirements; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the authority of the county commissioners of a code home rule county to establish a department of public facilities and services, abolish a water-or sewer authority or sanitary district or commission, transfer to a municipal corporation certain responsibilities and otherwise provide certain water and sewerage services. providing that, upon the adoption of a certain resolution by the County Commissioners of Worcester County, at the general election held in November, 1992, a question shall be placed on the ballot in Worcester County to canvass the opinion of the voters on whether the Sanitary Commission of Worcester County shall be abolished; providing that the results of the straw poll shall have no binding or legal effect; requiring the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Worcester County to take certain actions; and generally relating to a straw poll of the voters of Worcester County at the general election in November, 1992, concerning the abolishment of the Sanitary Commission.

BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

Article 25B Home Rule for Code Counties
