AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws – Nonresident Permit

FOR the purpose of requiring certain nonresidents of the State to obtain a nonresident's permit to operate a motor vehicle in this State; specifying procedures and requirements for application and issuance of the permit; providing for the establishment and disposition of certain fees; authorizing the Maryland Automobile Insurance Fund to issue a certain policy to a nonresident to whom a nonresident's permit is issued under certain conditions; and generally relating to the issuance of permits and certain security for nonresidents' motor vehicles.
