

policies of the President and the Speaker and the Legislative Policy Committee; authorizing the President and the Speaker to authorize the Legislative Accounting Office or a unit of the Legislative Branch to create accounts for revenue received from payments of fees or charges and to utilize the funds to provide services to individuals, organizations, or other units of State or local governments; providing that the funds in the accounts may only be expended in accordance with the budget or by budget amendment; providing for the reversion or retention of unexpended revenues in the accounts; providing for a certain notice to the State Comptroller's Office; making a technical change so as to require certain financial reports and information about the financial affairs of political subdivisions to be submitted to and be in a certain form provided by the Department of Fiscal Services; altering the number of days a financial officer of a political subdivision has to resubmit a financial report to the Department of Fiscal Services under certain circumstances; providing that the provisions of this Act relating to the appointment and employment status of the Administrator of the Legislative Accounting Office do not apply to the Administrator serving in the position on the effective date of this Act; and relating generally to the organization and duties of the Department of Fiscal Services of the General Assembly of Maryland.
