

(d) A report under this section shall include the affidavit of the financial officer and all of the following information that applies to the political subdivision:

(10) Any other information about the financial affairs of the political subdivision that the [Division] DEPARTMENT finds pertinent or appropriate and necessary to show accurately the financial condition of the political subdivision.

(e) (1) A financial officer may not fail:

(i) To submit a report under this section; or

(ii) Within [10] 15 days after receiving notice that the [Division] DEPARTMENT finds the report inadequate, to resubmit a report that meets the requirements of this section.

(2) A financial officer who violates any provision of this subsection is personally liable to the State for a penalty of \$10 for each day or part of a day for which the report is overdue.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act concerning the appointment of the Administrator of the Legislative Accounting Office do not apply to the individual serving as Administrator on the effective date of this Act and the Administrator serving on the effective date of this Act shall continue to serve in that position.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 599

(House Bill 1234)

AN ACT concerning

Mining – Reclamation

FOR the purpose of requiring that spoil from certain mining operations be reclaimed within the permitted area from which it originated or on an abandoned mine site in a certain manner; providing that spoil may not be placed on an abandoned mine site if it is needed to achieve certain contours to meet certain requirements within the permitted area; and generally relating to mining land reclamation.
