SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

297.

- (k) (1) If, after a full hearing, the court determines that the property should not be forfeited, the court shall order that the property be released.
- (2) (i) If EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (V) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, IF the court determines that the property should be forfeited, the court shall Forder:
- 1. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH 2 OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH, ORDER that the property be forfeited to the appropriate governing body; OR \_.
- 2. IF THE PROPERTY WAS SEIZED BY STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITIES, ORDER THAT THE PROPERTY BE FORFEITED TO THE FUND CREATED IN § 297C OF THIS SUBHEADING.
