

(i) A certificate of inspection is submitted to the Administration by a representative of a county police department or the State Police; and

(ii) A certificate of inspection is submitted to the Administration, as required by Title 23 of this article.

(2) On receipt of the required certificates of inspection and the salvage certificate, the Administration shall issue a new certificate of title bearing a conspicuous notice that indicates the vehicle was a salvage vehicle.]

(A) (1) A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE SHALL BE ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

(2) A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL:

(I) BE ISSUED IN THE NAME OF THE APPLICANT; AND

(II) SERVE AS AN OWNERSHIP DOCUMENT.

(B) THE ADMINISTRATION ~~MAY~~ SHALL ISSUE A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE:

(1) TO AN INSURANCE COMPANY THAT:

(I) IS LICENSED TO INSURE AUTOMOBILES IN THIS STATE;

(II) ACQUIRES A VEHICLE AS THE RESULT OF A CLAIM SETTLEMENT; AND

(III) WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF SETTLEMENT, APPLIES FOR A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION;

(2) TO AN AUTOMOTIVE DISMANTLER AND RECYCLER THAT:

(I) ACQUIRES A SALVAGE VEHICLE FROM A SOURCE OTHER THAN AN INSURANCE COMPANY LICENSED TO INSURE AUTOMOBILES IN THIS STATE;

(II) ACQUIRES A SALVAGE VEHICLE BY A MEANS OTHER THAN A TRANSFER OF A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE; AND

(III) APPLIES FOR A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION; OR

(3) TO ANY OTHER PERSON WHO:

(I) ACQUIRES OR RETAINS OWNERSHIP OF A VEHICLE THAT IS SALVAGE, AS DEFINED IN § 11-152 OF THIS ARTICLE;
